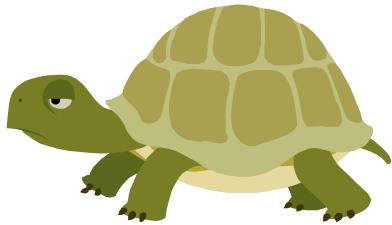
Adverbs tell us **more about verbs**. Many adverbs tell us **how** something happened. Many adverbs end in **ly**.
