

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#### Course Content

#### IGCSE Cambridge First Language English

'Cambridge IGCSE First Language English is designed for learners develop the ability to communicate clearly, accurately and effectively in both speech and writing. They learn how to employ a wide-ranging vocabulary, use correct grammar, spelling and punctuation, and develop a personal style and awareness of the audience being addressed.

Learners are also encouraged to read widely, both for their own enjoyment and to further their awareness of the ways in which English can be used. Cambridge IGCSE First Language English also develops more general analysis and communication skills such as synthesis, inference, and the ability to order facts and present opinions effectively'.

#### **AIMS**

The aims are to enable the learner to:

- Understand and respond to what they hear, read and experience
- Communicate accurately, appropriately, confidently and effectively.
- Enjoy and appreciate a variety of language.
- Complement their ability to work with information and ideas in the other areas of study, for example, by developing skills of analysis, synthesis and the drawing of inferences.
- Promote personal development and an understanding of themselves and others.

## How it works

IGCSE Cambridge First Language English is a 2 year course.

Year 1: 9 x monthly units

Year 2: 7 x monthly units

We give you a completion date for each unit!




The work is marked by one of our qualified IGCSE English tutors and written feedback is sent to you.


